### Checklist – Category C (contaminated soil) and Asbestos

Prior to disposal of contaminated material, either Category C soil or asbestos, customers/contractors are required to undertake the following:

1. Submit to the Senior Landfill Engineer the following, at least 48 hours (24 hours for asbestos) prior to disposal;
  - a. This completed checklist (both for asbestos and Cat C soil)
  - b. Completed pre-booking and summary sheet (Cat C soil only)
  - c. Copy of the test results (Cat C only)
  - d. Any additional information\*\*
2. Contact the Senior Landfill Engineer on (03) 5454 9504 to confirm a day\*\*\* and time\*\*\*\* for disposal.
3. Call the Eaglehawk Landfill on the day to confirm delivery arrangements, on (03) 5446 3917. This is necessary as weather conditions can prevent material being accepted.
4. Put in place a financial arrangement with City of Greater Bendigo to cover disposal charges.
5. Supply a copy of all completed paperwork and “EPA Transport Certificate” with the first load including:
  - a. This completed checklist (both for asbestos and Cat C soil)
  - b. Completed pre-booking and summary sheet (Cat C soil only)
  - c. Copy of the test results (Cat C only)

**If you have any further queries prior to disposal, please do not hesitate to contact Eaglehawk Landfill.**

NOTES

- \* All test results recorded on the 'pre-booking summary sheet' are to be the recorded maximums of the concentrations of the contaminants except in the event of an outlier in the test results in which case the 95%UCL<sub>average</sub> is to be used.  
In the event that the 95%UCL<sub>average</sub> is used, this needs to be identified with the results and for which contaminant.
  
- \*\* 'Any additional information' can include but is not limited to:
  - If the material has been transported from the origin of generation to a holding facility before final transportation and disposal.
  - Where the 95%UCL<sub>average</sub> has been used
  - Where total volume of material is reported but needs to be transported in multiple loads – number of expected loads is required.
  
- \*\*\* Both Cat C soil and Asbestos waste are only accepted Monday – Friday between the hours of 9:00am and 3:00pm.
  
- \*\*\*\* When a time is booked, a window of 2 hours is allowed FROM the booked time. If loads of contaminated waste materials arrive before or after the window of booked time, then these will not be accepted through the gate and the contractor/customer will be required to put in place a new booking arrangement.
