Permit conditions:

1. A copy of this permit must be available on request by an authorised officer.
2. Only dry untreated wood and timber may be burnt. All other material including leaves, green and damp vegetation, paper and cardboard cannot be burnt.
3. The permit is for a burn on one day only, however the timeframe approved allows you to choose the most suitable day to conduct your burn.
4. Be located no closer than 3 metres to the property boundary or any building.
5. Be cleared of any flammable material for a radius of 3 metres including trees.
6. No fires to be lit if wind speed is greater than 15kph.
7. Be constantly supervised by an adult until the fire is completely extinguished.
8. Have an adequate water supply such as a working water hose immediately available at the fire site.
9. Notify adjoining neighbours and give them as much notice as possible. Do not burn if smoke will impact your neighbours or if your neighbours object.
10. Register your burn-off with **CFA VICFIRE on 1800 668 511**, at least two hours before ignition.
