



FEATURES OF THE MASTER PLAN

- 1 Proposed car park**
Closure of Havlin Street East allows the addition of a formalised car park.
- 2 Connection of Back Creek Trail**
Closure of Havlin Street East allows Back Creek Trail to connect within the current road alignment providing pedestrian and cycle priority.
- 3 Revegetate Back Creek**
With the Back Creek Trail located out of the creek corridor there is an opportunity to revegetate Back Creek with some informal wetlands to improve water quality and local habitat.
- 4 Feature entry nodes**
Historical brick entry markers and wayfinding signage
- 5 Path network**
Central main path provides direct link through the park with secondary paths connecting to playspace and lawn areas.
- 6 Main social area**
Paved area with shelter, picnic tables, bins and drinking fountain.
- 7 Secondary social areas**
Paved area with picnic tables, bins and drinking fountain.
- 8 Playspace**
Existing playspace expanded to include more sensory play and adventure play for all ages. Central lookout features play items on the embankment.
- 9 Picnic lawn**
Lawn area between main social space and playspace, allows informal play and picnics.
- 10 Central lookout**
Seating area and observation point with accessible paths. Provides access to slides and climbing on the embankment.
- 11 Pump track**
New pump track with pump bumps, rollers and berms. Social area provides a hangout spot for pump track users.
- 12 Kick about lawn**
Kick about space with fun goals for informal sports and activities.
- 13 Landscape seating**
Informal seating and spectator space.
