TO REGISTER - IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- State Law requires that all dogs and cats over the age of 3 months are registered
- A dog or cat must be microchipped and **proof of microchipping supplied** prior to the registration being accepted (except where exempted by legislation)
- Animals owned by people under 18 must be registered in the name of a parent or guardian
- Your registration fee includes a State Government levy that is used to fund responsible pet ownership programs

Additional information

- Failure to renew registration by the due date may result in an infringement being issued
- To assist Council reuniting missing pets with owners please ensure all your registration information is accurate and up to date
- A maximum of 2 dogs and 2 cats can be kept at a residential property. A local Law permit will be required to keep more than this number

Reduced fee

If your dog or cat is eligible for a reduced fee, proof of eligibility is required.

Concession eligibility

If you wish to claim a concession you must supply proof of one of the following current cards:

**Either Centrelink pension card
or Department of Veteran Affairs pension card
or Health Care Card
or Seniors Health Care Card**

and indicate on the front of this notice the applicable concession type.
