BUSHFIRE PLACES OF LAST RESORT (formerly known as a Neighbourhood Safer Place)

A Bushfire Place of Last Resort is an area that may, as a last resort, provide some sanctuary from the life threatening effects of a bushfire.

Heathcote’s Bushfire Place of Last Resort is the Holy Rosary Primary School Oval; bounded by Ebden Street, Pohlman Street and Playne Street Heathcote (entry off Ebden Street or Pohlman Street).

DISABLED PARKING PERMITS AND BAYS

The City of Greater Bendigo issues parking permits as part of the Victorian Disabled Persons Parking Scheme. The scheme has two permit categories. Your eligibility must be confirmed by a medical practitioner.

Category one blue permits are for people with significant disabilities who meet the eligibility criteria. The permit entitles you to park in a special bay reserved for people with a disability for the specified time or any ordinary bay for twice the specified time (parking fees must be paid).

Category two green permits are for people who need rest breaks when walking. Temporary permits can be issued to an individual whose ability to walk is significantly restricted temporarily and is not likely to improve within 6 months. Green permit holders may park in any ordinary area or bay for twice the specified time (parking fees must be paid). These permits do not entitle holders to park in disabled persons' parking bays.

COMPANION CARD

Companion Cards are issued to people with a significant, permanent disability, who can demonstrate that they are unable to access most community activities and venues without attendant care support. On sighting the Companion Card, participating organisations issue the cardholder with a second ticket for their companion at no charge. Companion Cards can be used on all Victorian public transport.
