## BUSHFIRE PLACES OF LAST RESORT (formerly known as a Neighbourhood Safer Place)

A Bushfire Place of Last Resort is an area that may, as a last resort, provide some sanctuary from the life threatening effects of a bushfire.

The Eaglehawk Bushfire Place of Last Resort is Canterbury Park Sports Precinct car parks and events space (entry from Simpsons Road between the bowling greens and the lake).

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING PERMITS AND SPACES

These bays can only be used for vehicles displaying valid 'Disability Parking (ADP) Permits' (blue label), providing the vehicle has been parked by, or for the convenience of, the permit holder.

Vehicles displaying a 'Double Time Permit' (green label) must not be parked in an accessible parking bay. These vehicles can be parked in a standard parking bay for up to twice the normal time limit for that bay once the fee is paid.

## COMPANION CARD

Companion Cards are issued to people with a significant, permanent disability, who can demonstrate that they are unable to access most community activities and venues without attendant care support. On sighting the Companion Card, participating organisations issue the cardholder with a second ticket for their companion at no charge. Companion Cards can be used on all Victorian public transport.
